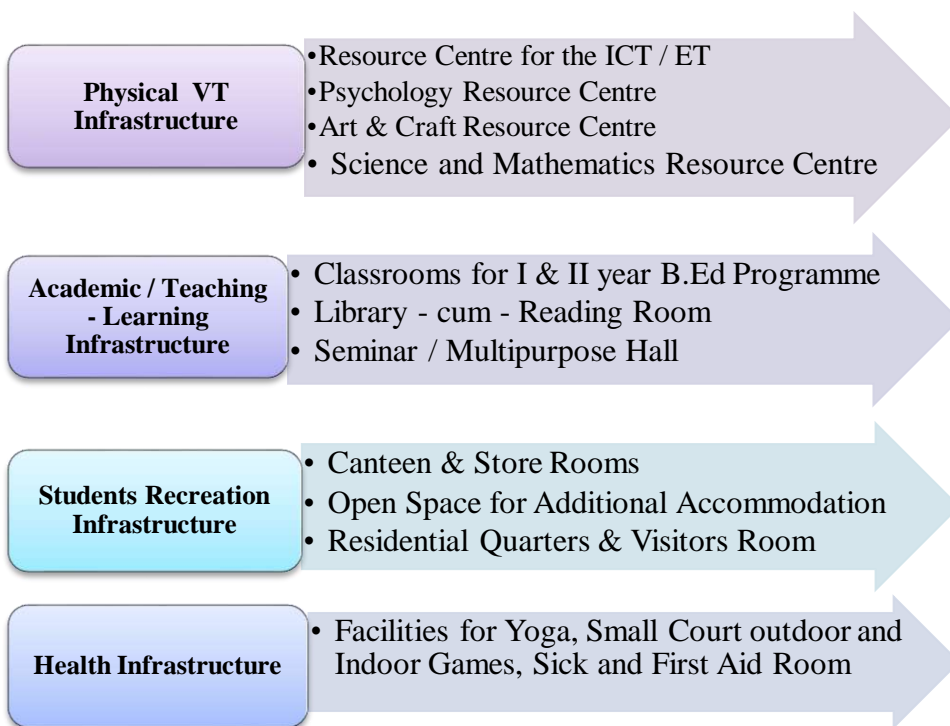

Our College is located at Muthugoundanpudur, about 2kms from the National Highway-NH-544. The Department of Psychology of the Dr.G.R.Damodaran College of Science (Autonomous) has been functioning as the facilitator. Sufficient space is also provided for conducting other activities like Workshops, Seminars, Camps, Physical Education Training and Recreation. Hostel facilities are also provided for both the Men and Women. Our College bus picks up the Students from the various destinations in the City.

ICT Laboratory Facilities

In the lab, 50 PCs with the most recent configuration are available. The systems are connected with the broadband internet facility. Each Student will create digital e-portfolios furnishing all their academic details. Flexibility and the ability to adapt with the technology and pedagogy are essential. ICT Labs offer a space for Students to explore, create, connect, and build digital literacy. We prepare our Student - Teachers for developing the following skills with the support of the ICT lab:

- ✳ Triggered general awareness among the prospective teachers about Information and Communication Technology (ICT) and its use in teaching and learning.
- ✳ Created PPT presentation embedded with audio and video.
- ✳ Taught to create a Blog and Edu-Blog for the sharing of knowledge.
- ✳ Created some innovative themes for the significant days and events.
- ✳ Taught various fonts like Baamini – Tamil Typing.

Language Lab

The language laboratory has been very useful for assessing the Student's Communication skills. It provides the Students with the technical tools to get the best samples of pronunciation of the language. A language laboratory is a dedicated space for foreign language learning where the Students access the audio-visual materials. They allow a teacher to listen to and manage the Student's audio, which is delivered to the individual Student through headsets or in isolated 'sound booths'.

Inauguration of the Two Year B.Ed Programme

As per the TNTEU University circular, the Dr. G. R. Damodaran College of Education Commenced Classes for the First-year Students from **5th September, 2023**. The Programme was inaugurated and the key note address delivered by Dr.P.D.Vandana Devi. The programme was followed by the orientation about the course, introduction of the faculty and the subjects handled by them.

A Student Teacher’s Portfolio is a compilation of the academic work for the purpose of evaluation of the course quality, learning progress and the academic achievements.



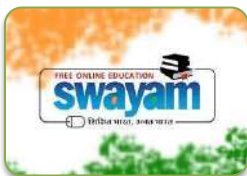
COMMUNITY BASED ENGAGEMENT AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT CHRONICLE

INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME

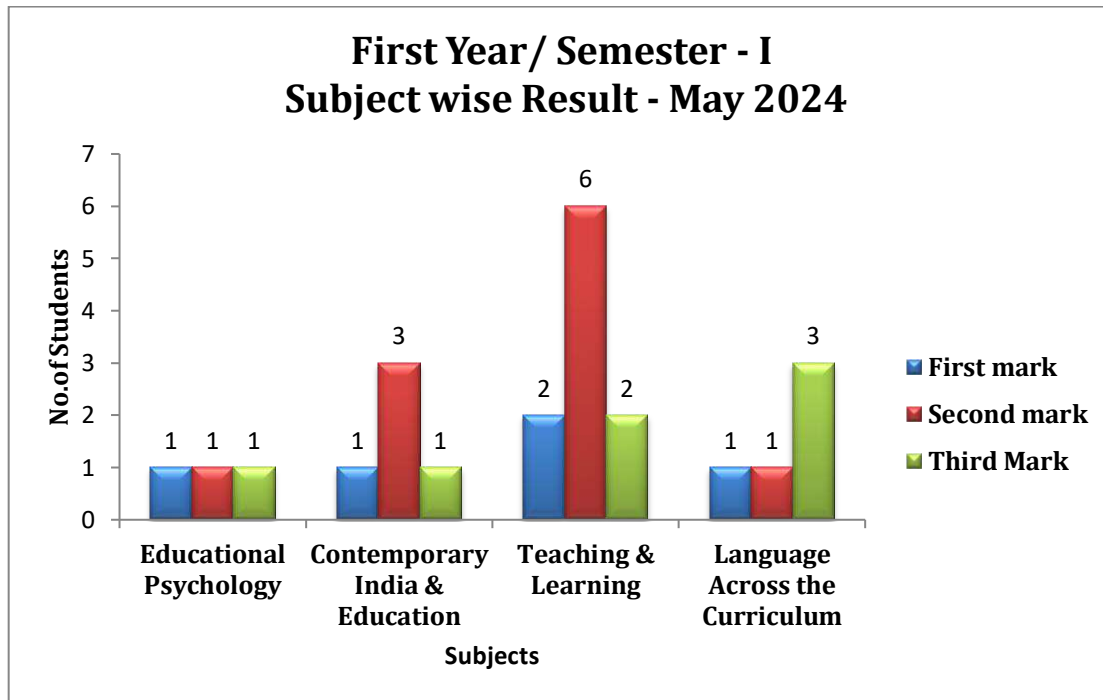

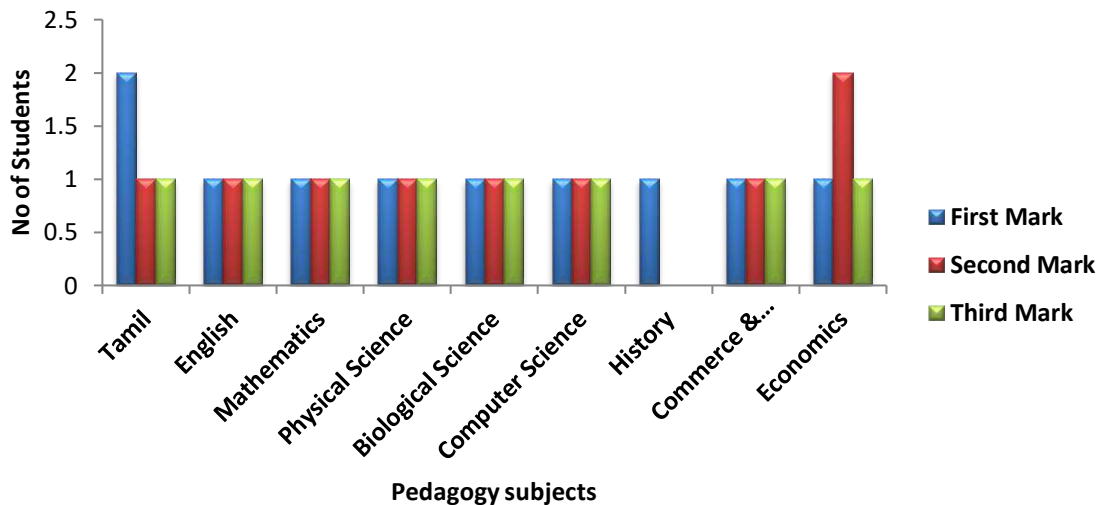
University Examination Result

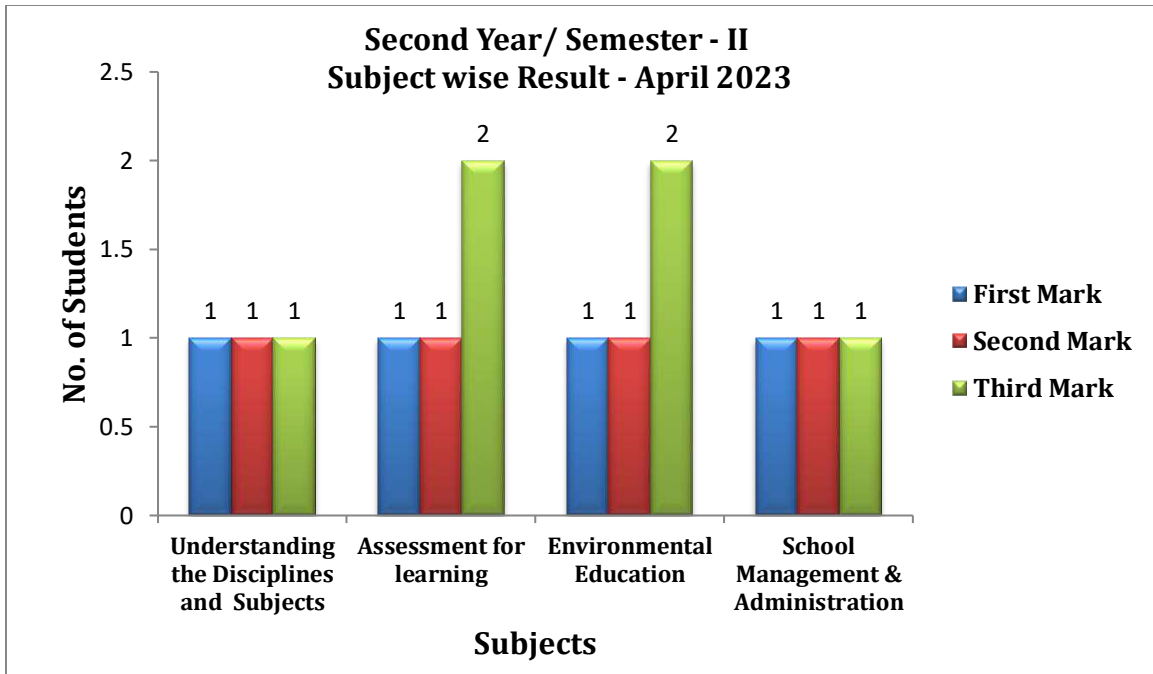

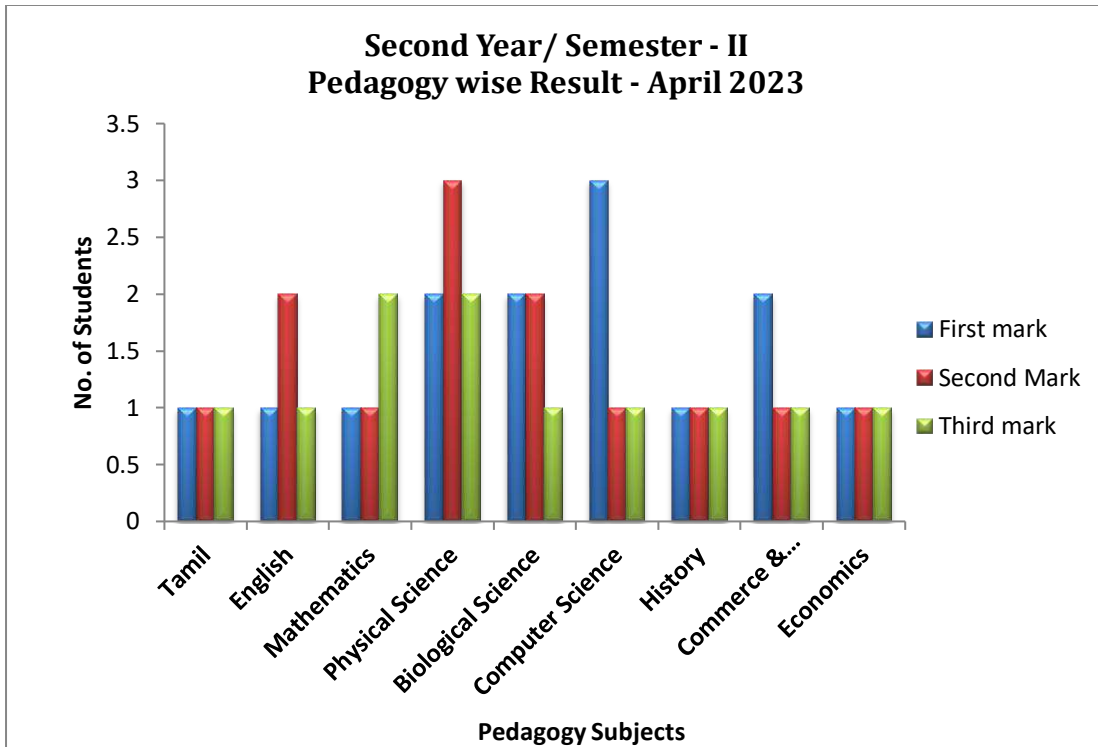
First Year/ Semester - I Pedagogy wise Result - May 2024



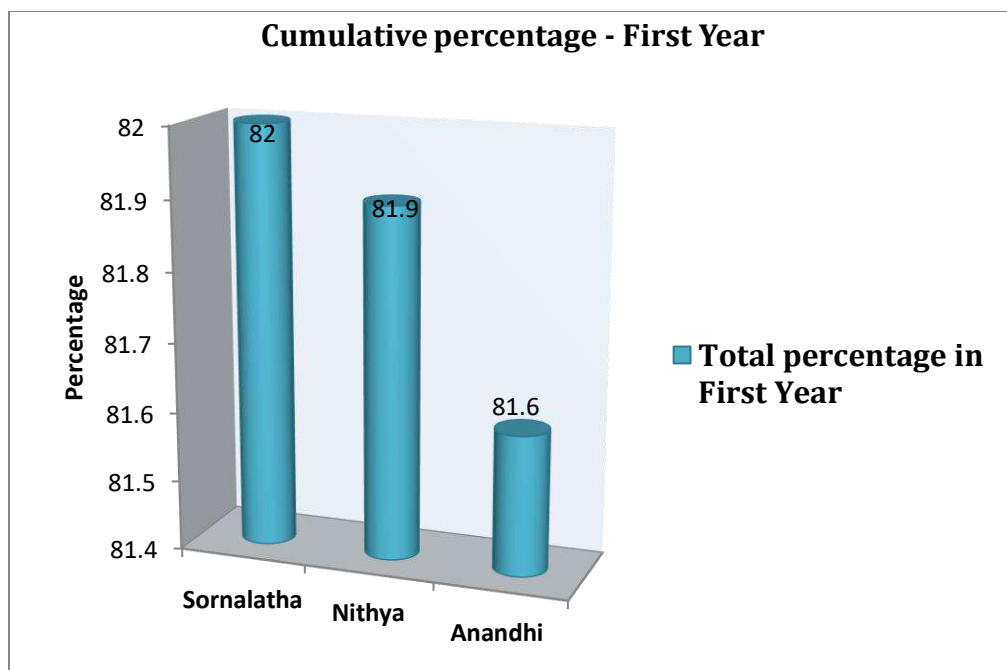
