Stimulated by Prof. Dr. G R Damodaran's intellectual inspiration, motivation, encouragement and support, Dr. D. Padmanaban, Chairman and Correspondent, GRD Institutions and Smt. Geetha Padmanaban, Secretary, GRD Institutions established the Dr. G.R. DAMODARAN COLLEGE OF SCIENCE, (Autonomous) as a monumental tribute to the dedication and commitment of Prof. G R Damodaran. Dr. G.R. DAMODARAN COLLEGE OF SCIENCE, (Autonomous) perceives education as a multi dimensional continuum with several interrelated yet distinct goals, concerns, functions and activities.

Dr. D. Padmanaban, one of the Founders who is a doctorate in Management, is a distinguished Educationist - Entrepreneur of Coimbatore.

He is the Director of the Centre for Research in Social Sciences, Technology & Culture of the Trust, Chief Editor of the Trust's scientific monthlies, WIDE SPECTRUM and KALAIKATHIR and Correspondent of the Educational Institutions of the Trust. Dr. D. Padmanaban was a member of several national-level committees including the National Advisory Committee, Science & Technology Entrepreneur's Parks (STEP) of the DST, Govt. of India, Planning Board of the Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) (Visitor's Nominee), Faculty Selection Committee of the North-Eastern Hill University, Shillong (NEHU), (Visitor's Nominee), Syndicate of the Bharathiar University, Coimbatore (Chancellor's Nominee), Research Council of the IGNOU, Executive Council, Pondicherry Central University (Visitor's Nominee), Task Force on Biotechnology based programmes for the Rural Population of the DBT, Govt. of India, etc.

In the thirty six years since its commencement, the Dr. GRD COLLEGE OF SCIENCE, (Autonomous) has grown from 27 students in two UG courses to over 4000 Students in numerous Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Research (M.Phil / Ph.D) programmes in many of the modern and emerging **Professional** and Scientific disciplines. In November 2001, the College was accredited by the NATIONAL ASSESSMENT AND ACCREDITATION COUNCIL (NAAC) of the UGC at the FIVE STAR level becoming one among the only 25 Such Institutions in the Country at that time and the first in the Unaided Sector. The College was again re-accredited by the NAAC at the 'A' Grade level. The College has obtained the ISO 9001:2015 certification testifying to the outstanding quality focus built into all its systems and processes. The **College** has been granted **Autonomy** by the UGC and Bharathiar University from 2004 - 2005 which enables it to frame its own innovative and relevant curriculum and evaluation systems. The degrees are awarded by the Bharathiar University.

The College has been ranked in the top 100 rank band at the All India level, released by the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), National Board of Accreditation (NBA), under the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, for the year 2023.

The alumni of the College occupy positions of great responsibility in different Companies in India and abroad. The Faculty has been successful in mobilizing highly competitive research and extension project grants from the **national funding agencies** like the **DST**, **DBT**, **UGC**, **MHRD**, etc. A large number of eminent personalities visit the College every year and deliver lectures. The College regularly organizes **National Level Seminars, Conferences and Workshops** to update the Students about the recent developments in the respective fields of study. Four Major Research Projects and four Minor Research **Projects have been sanctioned by the UGC. Students thus, gain experience in research methodology by assisting the Principal Investigators of the research projects**.

GOALS AND APPROACHES

Following the footsteps of Prof. G.R. Damodaran, the College designs its own innovative curricula, teaching methods and a Student centered active learning environment so as to:

- Develop a comprehensive understanding, creativity and professional competence among the Student community.
- Supplement the regular Course work with exceptional inputs like providing need based training and other extra curricular activities, to enhance the employability of our Students, as well as to promote adaptability to inculcate confidence, leadership and social skills.
- Inculcate a wide spectrum of knowledge so that our Students will be thoroughly prepared for Careers in modern and emerging areas of opportunity and to develop an inherent potential for continual growth and achievement.

INFRASTRUCTURE AND STUDENTS' FACILITIES

The College has set up extensive and well designed physical facilities including well furnished and spacious Class rooms, well equipped Bioscience Laboratories, Plant Tissue Culture facility, Computer Centres with internet facility, Wifi facility in the campus, Language Labs, Canteen, Digital Printing and Photostat facility, stationery, Air-Conditioned Conference Halls, Charles Babbage Conference Hall, Peter Drucker Conference Hall, SCIB Conference Hall, Sankaradas Swamigal Auditorium, Placement Halls, Board Rooms, the Rukmini Damodaran Auditorium, Kailash Indoor Stadium, Audio Visual Halls and well stocked and staffed Libraries with 48,950 books and 130 periodicals / journals.

The separate **Hostels** and **messes** for the **Men** and **Women** in the campus possess the capacity to house **365** boys and **365** girls besides

all the modern amenities including **recreation halls**, **games rooms**, **internet** and **gymnasium facilities**. All facilities for a hygienic and a comfortable living, relaxation and entertainment and for undisturbed study are provided. The College can help make available some accommodation in its off Campus Hostels. Strict rules and procedures are followed to maintain discipline and ensure security and wellbeing of the Hostel inmates. The messes work on the dividing system. The spacious campus has playgrounds and facilities for **Basketball**, **Cricket**, **Table tennis**, **Chess**, **Carrom**, **Volleyball and Athletics**. The Hostel Mess cost is quite nominal.

An active Placement Cell has been functioning at the College with considerable success. A good number of Students have been placed in Companies like WIPRO, STANCHART, INFOSYS, TCS, COGNIZANT, FORD, ACCENTURE, LUCID IMAGING, STANDARD CHARTERED BANK, HDFC, CITI BANK, E&Y, TATA, HCL, BOSCH, KOTAK BANK, FEDERAL BANK, AMAZON, etc. To ensure the safety of the Women Students in the campus, the College has constituted the Grievances Redressal Cell, to which the Students can approach for any kind of assistance. The College also runs a Student Dialogue Centre to help the Students to tide over difficult situations. To ensure a ragging free campus, the College has set up the Ragging Prevention Committee and Students are free to contact the members round the clock. To fulfill the Students' requirements, a grievance box is available in the main block in which the Students can drop their complaints, queries or suggestions by furnishing their identity.

Service associations like the National Service Scheme, College Social Service League, Youth Red Cross, Red Ribbon Club, and the Entrepreneurship Development Cell are fully functional in the campus.

Postgraduate Courses, M. Phil. and Ph. D. programmes are available in the College in all the areas of study covered by the Undergraduate Courses, and any Student can pursue Higher Studies and research if he / she so wishes at the College itself.

These facilities provide the most conducive ambience for the

Student learning, extra curricular activities, residential and cultural and personality development pursuits. Students like the calm campus with all the amenities so close to the City, situated right on the arterial four lane road (NH - 544). Our Students enjoy the action packed life brimming with activities and meets. The College also leads all the rest in Tamilnadu.

The College has continually updated the curriculum to suit the State of the Art needs of the industry and business. For example the introduction of Air & Sea Navigation Systems for the PG Computer Science Students, Digital Marketing, Media Data Bases and UI and UX Design for Visual Communication Students besides Non Linear Editing and Direction. Advanced Micro Controllers are also available for the UG Computer Science Students as an optional. Bioinformatics practices have also been included in the Biotechnology syllabus. Underwater Networking and Computing, Telescope and Space Science, Quantum Computing, Robotics, Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning are the recent additions to the Syllabi.

INSTITUTIONAL CALENDAR AND WORKING TIMINGS :

The **College** works on the **Semester pattern** with the **odd Semester** generally falling between the **first week of June** and the **end of October** and the **even Semester** between **early December** and **Mid-April.** A total of **92 working days** per **Semester** are the minimum required and **Students** shall compulsorily put in **75%** attendance. The period between the end of a **Semester** and the beginning of the next, accommodates the **Semester** examinations and the vacation.

UG classes are scheduled from **9.30 a.m.** to **3.50 p.m.** with a lunch break between **1.00 p.m.** and **2.00 p.m.** on the **six days-a-week** format. **Faculty members** are normally available upto **4.10 p.m.** Remedial classes for **Under Graduate Students** are often arranged on holidays also. The **College** office is open from **9.05 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.**

The Library is open from 9.05 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. on all days except Sundays on which it is open until 1.00 p.m. The Computer Centres are likewise open between 9.05 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Internet facility is available in the evening for the non-class room use of the Students. Around 300 new generation Computers are available including the APPLE i Mac COMPUTERS along with the State of the Art Software for use by the Students.

ADMISSIONS

Admissions to the Undergraduate Courses are made on the basis of merit (+1/+2 marks). The **College** is keen that Students should apply themselves with seriousness and commitment to their Studies and related activities so that they derive the maximum benefit and bring credit to the **College**. To this end, applicants are urged to read carefully the section on '**Courses**' in this brochure and select the Courses according to their requirements.

Applications for admission should be submitted in the prescribed forms available at the College office from the first week of April on payment of Rs. 300/- for UG Courses, Rs. 450/- for PG Courses (and Rs. 500/- for MCA and MBA) thro' Cash or a D.D. favouring the Principal, Dr. G.R. Damodaran College of Science, (Autonomous) payable at Coimbatore. Postal requests for application forms should be accompanied with a stamped (Rs. 25/-) self-addressed envelope of size 25 cms x 15 cms. (Otherwise, Rs. 25/may be added to the application form remittance).

A **single application** may be used for all the Courses within **each of the following groups** indicating the order of preference of the **Courses within the group.** Separate applications are needed if one wishes to apply for the Courses in different groups.

The duration of the above mentioned courses is 3 (three) years (6 semesters).

The list of Courses with their eligibility requirements and the scope for Employment / Higher Study is furnished later in this booklet.

Note : One Value Added / Career Oriented Course will be offered to each Student on the basis of the choice and appropriateness. These courses are supplementary and run over a period of 3 years in three stages : I year -Certificate; II year - Diploma and III year - Advanced Diploma. The subject areas of these courses are such as to prepare a Student for a well defined career / employment opportunity and the methodology will comprise class room lectures with parts handled by Practising Experts, Visiting Professionals / Practicals / Hands on work / Assignments and Internship / Project reports for about a month.

LAST DATE FOR APPLICATIONS:

Filled in applications will be accepted until 10 days after the publication of the Tamilnadu +2 Results. However, prospective applicants are advised to apply early with available details; final examination marks may be submitted later quoting the Course and the application number without fail for reference. In this way, Students with good records could be afforded preference during the provisional selection.

Instructions to the applicants

1. A self addressed post card should be enclosed along with the application if acknowledgment of its receipt is desired.

True copies of the mark sheets of each appearance in all the examinations passed (including +1) should be attached. If the final examination Marks Sheet is not available, it may be forwarded later indicating the Course and the application number.

The reference number imprinted on the right hand top corner of the application form should be quoted in all the correspondence.

2. Provisionally selected candidates will be called to produce their original certificates. In person visits and enquiries at the College are also welcome during the working hours. Students / Parents are also invited to go round the College, Labs and Libraries during the working hours to gain first hand knowledge of the facilities available.

A call letter for interview does not confer any right of admission. Applicants for admission must produce the original and a photostat copy of each of the following at the time of admission :

Parents. (Aadhar Card-Xerox Copy)

- **G** Foreign Nationals should, in addition, submit :
 - i) Copies of the Visa and Passport
 - ii) Staying Visa
 - iii) Address Proof (Local)
 - iv) Police Verification (Local)
 - v) Equivalence Certificate from the Association of Indian Universities, Govt. of India, New Delhi.
 - vi) Age relaxation as per the rules of our University.

(Any of the certificates yet to be obtained may be produced as soon as they are received) (but before the 30^{th} of July).

- 4. The decision of the Management regarding admissions shall be final and binding. However, the University's eligibility norms will be strictly followed.
- 5. If selected, applicants should be prepared to deposit their original Certificates*, remit the fee determined and join immediately. No extension of time for joining the programmes will ordinarily be granted. Fee and advances once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances. Transfer within the College from one course to another may be considered, if seats are available.

*Applicants are advised to make and keep with them

sufficient number of attested copies of all their Certificates before submitting the original Certificates. Certificates submitted to the College cannot be returned except at the time of the Student's leaving the College, clearing all his/her dues and after producing the "No dues" Certificate.

- 6. Admissions should be ordinarily completed before the 31st of July and all the original documents in support of the qualifications and eligibility must be produced before that date. Applicants failing to do so cannot get their admissions confirmed and will have to leave, foregoing the amounts remitted by them.
- 7. The College has to comply with the rules and regulations of the Bharathiar University governing admissions; therefore all admissions are provisional, subject to the approval of the University. While the College takes every care to ensure the eligibility of the candidates, it will not be responsible for any hardships that may arise in rare cases due to the University detecting any invalidity / ineligibility or discrepancy and refusing approval for admission.

Applicants (particularly those with qualifications from abroad or other states) are advised to independently ascertain the salient features of the relevant regulations regarding the eligibility for admission from the Bharathiar University in their own interest.

- 8. Students are admitted on the understanding that they will strictly abide by the rules and regulations of the College and meticulously follow the instructions issued by the authorities from time to time. In particular, the College insists on a high level of attendance, diligence in Course work and good behaviour in the campus and outside. Students who fall short of these expectations may be asked to leave, in which case they will not be eligible for any refund of the fees remitted by them.
- 9. Fee and advances once remitted will not be refunded on any account. This will cover the cases of Students who discontinue on their own or due to the invalidity of the admissions under clauses 5 and 6 above and those who have to leave under clause 7 above.
- 10. It is expected that admissions to the Under Graduate Courses would close within thirty days from the date of the publication of the +2 results and hence prospective applicants are advised to contact the College quite early for obtaining the applications.
- 11. Remittance of advances in piecemeal by the

applicants will not be permissible (Ex : Rs. 5,000/-, etc.).

- 12. Students who are identified to be detrimental to the discipline of the College will be summarily dismissed from the College / Hostels after informing the Parents / Guardians. Those indulging in violence will be dealt with according to the provisions of the law. Students found using drugs will be punished under the Indian Penal Code / other laws.
- 13. Disciplinary action will be initiated against the Students visiting the other College Campuses without the permission of the authorities.
- 14. Action will be initiated against the other College Students if found entering the GRD Campuses without the permission of their Management in writing.
