**MINUTES OF THE MEETING**

Student's welfare committee meeting was held on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2024 at 11.30 am in Principal's Office, where The Principal, Dr. G. R. Damodaran College of Science was the key person and chairman for the meeting. Directors, HOD's and student's welfare committee members were present for the meeting. The points discussed in the meeting are highlighted below:

- The Chairman welcomed the gathering and addressed the importance of the present meeting that it would be helpful of the development of various activities of students, both academic and extra-curricular so that the college could provide an environment for the students to reach their achievements
- To make the students to feel comfortable in the new environment, Student Induction Programme for the first year U.G. and P.G. students will be organized
- The placement cell has planned the training activities to enhance the employability opportunities for the students.
- The chairman insisted the English Department faculties to conduct the language based training for the students. Separate schedule to be followed for the lab sessions.
- Placement Training and Career Counselling are planned to guide and motivate

the students to get placement in reputed companies.

- It is decided to organize CyberSecurity Awareness Programme for all the students.
- The NSS and YRC clubs were asked to conduct various awareness programmes for the welfare of the students Road Safety Awareness, Drugs awareness programmes.
- A periodic doctor's visit will be planned to provide health checkup for the students.
- A common room facility for the girl students was insisted.
- To cater to the needs of the students the management has planned to upgrade the canteen.
